

From March 5 to 12, 2026, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 2,350 U.S. likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and recalled presidential vote. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error associated with the sample size is ±2 percentage points. Results for subgroups of the sample are subject to increased margins of error. Partisanship reflected in tabulations is based on self-identified party affiliation, not partisan registration. For more information please visit dataforprogress.org/our-methodology.

This sample is also weighted to account for oversamples of self-identified Independents and swing districts voters with unweighted Ns of 1,121 and 499, respectively, to ensure proportional representation of likely voters.

"Swing districts" here are defined as congressional districts identified by the DCCC as "Districts in Play" or "Frontline".

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
