

From November 5 to November 6, 2020, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1095 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English.

**This report is filtered to only the 99 respondents whose zip code is in a "Whitopia" county. The topline margin of error is ±10.0 percentage points.**

Here, a "Whitopia" is defined as a suburban/exurban county that is at least 85 percent non-Hispanic white; with population growth since 2000 of at least 6 percent; and with the majority of that growth coming from non-Hispanic whites. The U.S. has 3,142 counties; 284 of them qualify as "Whitopias".

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 10 (<10) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<10 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
