

DATA FOR **PROGRESS**

From October 8 to 10, 2021, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 467 likely Democratic primary voters in Arizona using SMS text-to-web to contact voters. Because of Arizona's primary system, prospective respondents were Democratic and independent voters sampled from the September 2021 version of the voter file. The responses were weighted to be representative of likely Democratic primary voters in Arizona by age, gender, education, race, and geography. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ± 5 percentage points, and the design effect from weighting is 1.4.

This survey relied entirely on responses from text-to-web contacts to ensure these results are most accurate for primary elections, as DFP finds respondents who complete text-to-web surveys are more politically engaged than those who complete surveys using other modes. This higher engagement allows DFP to approximate a Democratic primary electorate as closely as possible. It is also important to note that not all Democrats vote in Democratic primaries. Additionally, we report self-identified partisanship in our crosstabs rather than party registration from the voter file.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 40 (<40) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<40 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
