



From October 29 to November 1, 2021, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,177 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±3 percentage points.

N=1,177 unless otherwise specified. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

for seniors and people with disabilities, expand Medicare
coverage to include hearing, invest in clean energy, extend
tax credits for families with children, and provide subsidies
for child care.
