

From March 19 to March 21, 2021, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1291 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±3 percentage points.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

[2] Some lawmakers in Congress are proposing a bill that would require a background check for all gun purchases. The law would make it a crime for anyone who is not a licensed firearms dealer, even if they have no prior record of criminal activity, to purchase a gun from a friend without a government performed background check. This proposal would leave some exemptions for gun transfers among family and temporary transfers (like lending a gun) while hunting. Would you support or oppose this proposal?
