

DATA FOR **PROGRESS**

From March 26 to 29, 2021, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,400 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ± 3 percentage points.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

[2] The current federal minimum wage is \$7.25 an hour. The Raise the Wage Act is a proposal to raise it so that minimum wage would be increased to \$15 per hour by 2025.

[3] The current federal minimum wage is \$7.25 an hour. The Raise the Wage Act is a proposal to gradually raise it. The minimum wage would first be increased to \$9.50 an hour in 2021. Then, the minimum wage would be increased by \$1.50 an hour or less every year through 2025.
