

From April 16 to April 19, 2021, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1138 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±3 percentage points.

Some lawmakers in Congress are now proposing creating new standards so that no one party has an advantage in how congressional districts are created, this is sometimes called partisan gerrymandering. Specifically, this standard would make it such that if one party won about half the votes in a state, they should be able to win about half the congressional seats in that state as well.

Some lawmakers in Congress are considering changing Senate procedure to allow for this proposal to pass with 51 votes, rather than 60 votes, meaning Democrats could pass the bill without support from Republicans.
