

From May 14 to 17, 2021, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,203 registered voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of the adult population in the United States by age, gender, education, and race. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±3 percentage points.
