

## DATA FOR **PROGRESS**

From April 23 to 25, 2021, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,189 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is  $\pm 3$  percentage points.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

**[1]** The American Rescue Plan, a \$1.9 trillion pandemic relief package signed into law in March 2021, expanded the child tax credit to cover most families with children, with a benefit of up to \$3,000 for each child aged 17 and under, and \$3,600 for each child that is younger than 6.
