

DATA FOR PROGRESS

On June 22, 2021, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 601 likely New York City Democratic primary voters using SMS respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of the likely Democratic primary electorate by age, gender, education, race, borough, and voting history; and has been weighted to the election-night mayoral results (i.e. Eric Adams 32%, Maya Wiley 22%, etc). The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ± 4 percentage points.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 25 (<25) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<25 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
