

From June 12 to 20, 2021, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 848 likely voters in West Virginia using SMS and web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±3 percentage points.
