## THE DATA FOR PROGRESS

From September 15 to 17, 2021, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,346 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±3 percentage points.

N=1,346 unless otherwise specified. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

[1] As part of a pandemic relief package, people who were unemployed received federal unemployment payments, in addition to their regular state benefits. The federal supplement started at \$600 per week and was later reduced to \$300 per week.
