

## Fighting Chance *for* Families

From September 15 to 17, 2021, Fighting Chance for Families conducted a survey of 1,346 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is  $\pm 3$  percentage points.

Fighting Chance for Families is a project of Data for Progress and Groundwork Collaborative.

N=1,346 unless otherwise specified. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

**[1]** The expanded Child Tax Credit provides most families with tax credits worth up to \$250 per month for each child 17 and under – and \$300 per month for each child they have under 6 years of age. The first round of expanded Child Tax Credits were sent in July 2021. Families will receive monthly credits till December 2021.
