## D DATA FOR PROGRESS

From October 11 to 17, 2022, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 893 likely voters in Arizona using SMS and web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English and Spanish. The margin of error is $\pm 3$ percentage points. $\mathrm{N}=893$ unless otherwise specified. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than $50(<50)$ are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display $\mathrm{N}<50$ subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
