

From January 18 to 24, 2022, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 598 likely voters in Ohio's 4th congressional district using SMS and web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and votinghistory. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±4 percentage points.
