

# DATA FOR **PROGRESS**

From May 10 to 15, 2022, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 497 likely Democratic primary voters in Florida's new 10th congressional district using SMS and web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, and race. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is  $\pm 4$  percentage points.

N=497 unless otherwise specified. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
