

# DATA FOR **PROGRESS**

From September 16 to 20, 2022, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,006 likely voters in Georgia using SMS and web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is  $\pm 3$  percentage points.
