

# DATA FOR **PROGRESS**

From September 14 to 19, 2022, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 874 likely voters in Nevada using SMS and web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is  $\pm 3$  percentage points.
