

From September 16 to 19, 2022, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,215 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±3 percentage points.

**[33]** Some lawmakers have proposed that the U.S. should support diplomatic negotiations to end the war in Ukraine quickly, as long as an agreement could be found that preserves Ukrainian independence.

Advocates of diplomacy believe negotiations will prevent further loss of life, that it will be impossible to end the war by military means alone without great risks, and that we can seek compromises with Russia which preserve Ukrainian independence.

Opponents of negotiations say that reaching a diplomatic solution through compromise would not punish Russia enough for its aggression, and that it is worth extending the war for as long as it takes to try to fully defeat Russia.
