

DATA FOR PROGRESS

From December 22 to 27, 2022, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,228 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ± 3 percentage points.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

[1] The recreational use of marijuana entails adults over the age of 21 consuming THC infused products, including flower, edibles, etc.

[2] In March 2021, New York state passed the Marijuana Regulation and Taxation Act. This law legalized the adult-use of recreational marijuana in the state.

One policy measure in the law mandates that the first 100-200 licenses given out to open recreational marijuana dispensaries in the state will be reserved for "individuals from communities that were disproportionately impacted by the enforcement of cannabis prohibition" and other underrepresented groups.

[3] In March 2021, New York state passed the Marijuana Regulation and Taxation Act. This law legalized the adult-use of recreational marijuana in the state.

One policy measure in the law diverts 40% of the marijuana revenue collected by the state to the NYS Community Reinvestment Grant Fund.

Through this fund, local non-profit organizations and governments can apply for funding to support several community-based initiative programs, such as job placement and skill services, substance use treatment programs, and financial literacy courses.

If the **federal** government were going to legalize the adult-use of recreational marijuana and this policy measure was in the bill, would you support or oppose the passing of the bill? (*N=606*)
