## D DATA FOR PROGRESS

From September 29 to October 3, 2023, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 551 likely Democratic primary voters in New Jersey using SMS and web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is $\pm 4$ percentage points.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than $40(<40)$ are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display $N<40$ subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
