From February 22 to March 6, 2023, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,042 LGBTQ+ adults using web panel respondents in the following states: Alabama, Arkansas, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, and Virginia. Respondents were defined as LGBTQ if they identified with a sexual orientation other than straight or heterosexual, a gender identity other than male or female, or both. The sample was weighted to be representative of the adult LGBTQ+ community by age, gender, education, race, and geography using the 2015-2017 Gallup Daily Tracking survey sourced from The Williams Institute, UCLA School of Law LGBT Demographic Data Interactive. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±3 percentage points.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

From February 22 to March 6, 2023, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 709 religious LGBTQ adults using web panel respondents in the following states: Alabama, Arkansas, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, and Virginia. Respondents were defined as religious who did not respond "not applicable" to "How open are you about your sexual orientation or gender identity in your religious community?" Respondents were defined as LGBTQ if they identified with a sexual orientation other than straight or heterosexual, a gender identity other than male or female, or both. The sample was weighted to be representative of the adult LGBTQ community by age, gender, education, race, and geography using the 2015-2017 The Williams Institute, UCLA School of Law LGBT Demographic Data Interactive. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±3 percentage points.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
