

From October 19, 2022 to May 21, 2023, Data for Progress conducted 3 surveys of a total of 3,660 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The surveys were conducted from October 19th to 25th, 2022, May 17th to 18th, 2023, and May 19th to 21st, 2023. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±2 percentage points.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 25 (<25) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<25 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
