

DATA FOR PROGRESS

From October 13 to 19, 2023, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,240 U.S. likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ± 3 percentage points.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

[19] Recently, some lawmakers proposed a new law called the Civilian Climate Corps for Jobs and Justice Act. This program would be similar to the American Climate Corps (ACC), but offer additional benefits for corps members and hire a much larger number of individuals. This program will hire **300,000** Americans per year over five years.

Under this new proposal, members will also receive the **additional** following benefits:

- Earning at least \$17 an hour with full benefits, including health care
- \$25,000 in educational funding per year of service, up to \$50,000 in total
- At least half of corps members hired will come from under-resourced communities, and at least half of corps projects will be in under-resourced communities
