## 떼 DATA FOR PROGRESS

From April 19 to 22, 2024, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,265 U.S. likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, andvoting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is $\pm 3$ percentage points.

Swing state voter is defined as voter living in: Arizona, Georgia, Michigan, North Carolina, Nevada, Pennsylvania, or Wisconsin.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than $50(<50)$ are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display $\mathrm{N}<50$ subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
