From May 15 to 16, 2024, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,203 U.S. likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and 2020 recalled vote. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ±3 percentage points.

Results for crosstabs of subgroups of the sample are subject to increased margins of error. The design effect for split A is 1.38 and for split B is 1.27. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding. For more information, visit dataforprogress.org/our-methodology.
