

DATA FOR PROGRESS

From June 5 to 6, 2024, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,238 U.S. likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and 2020 recalled vote. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error associated with the sample size is ±3 percentage points. Results for subgroups of the sample are subject to increased margins of error. Partisanship reflected in tabulations is based on self-identified party affiliation, not partisan registration. For more information please visit dataforprogress.org/our-methodology.

[7] Last week, President Biden announced a three-phase ceasefire proposal to end the war in Gaza. The proposal includes:

- A complete ceasefire and withdrawal of Israeli forces from Gaza
- The release of Israeli hostages in exchange for hundreds of Palestinian prisoners
- A surge of humanitarian aid into Gaza
- Allowing displaced Palestinians to return to their homes in northern Gaza and starting a 3-5 year reconstruction plan for the region, backed by the United States, Europe, and international institutions
