

DATA FOR PROGRESS

From May 30 to June 1, 2025, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,232 U.S. likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and recalled presidential vote. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error associated with the sample size is ±3 percentage points. Results for subgroups of the sample are subject to increased margins of error. Partisanship reflected in tabulations is based on self-identified party affiliation, not partisan registration. For more information please visit dataforprogress.org/our-methodology.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

[16] Lawmakers in Congress are proposing a tax and spending bill. It would:

- Extend tax cuts for all individuals and corporations, with most of these benefitting high-income households
- Remove taxes on tips and overtime pay, and increase the Child Tax Credit by \$500 per child for most families
- Cut over \$700 billion from Medicaid and \$300 billion from Affordable Care Act subsidies
- Cut over \$300 billion from Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, or food assistance)
- Increase military and border security spending by more than \$200 billion in total
- Add about \$4 trillion dollars to the national debt (also known as the federal deficit)
