## **ATA FOR PROGRESS**

From June 27 to July 1, 2025, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,168 U.S. likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, income, race, geography, and recalled presidential vote. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error associated with the sample size is ±3 percentage points. Results for subgroups of the sample are subject to increased margins of error. Partisanship reflected in tabulations is based on self-identified party affiliation, not partisan registration. For more information please visit dataforprogress.org/our-methodology.

An oversample of Asian respondents was conducted to achieve minimum 120 interviews and weighted to ensure proportional representation of likely voters.

A "persuadable congressional voter" is defined as a voter who is either undecided on a generic congressional ballot or self-reports voting for candidates of both parties about evenly.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 40 (<40) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<40 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

## ₼ DATA FOR **PROGRESS**

From May 30 to June 1, 2025, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,232 U.S. likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, income, race, geography, and recalled presidential vote. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error associated with the sample size is ±3 percentage points. Results for subgroups of the sample are subject to increased margins of error. Partisanship reflected in tabulations is based on self-identified party affiliation, not partisan registration. For more information please visit dataforprogress.org/our-methodology.

An oversample of Asian respondents was conducted to achieve minimum 120 interviews and weighted to ensure proportional representation of likely voters.

A "persuadable congressional voter" is defined as a voter who is either undecided on a generic congressional ballot or self-reports voting for candidates of both parties about evenly.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 45 (<45) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<45 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance.
