

From July 11 to 17, 2025, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 531 New York City 2025 Democratic primary voters using SMS and web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and vote history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error associated with the sample size is ±4 percentage points. Results for subgroups of the sample are subject to increased margins of error. Oversamples of respondents in NY-10 and NY-15 were conducted to achieve a minimum of 100 interviews in each congressional district and were weighted to ensure proportional representation of those districts within the overall New York City Democratic primary electorate.

NB: subgroups with a n-size less than 50 (<50) are not shown on these cross-tabs. We choose not to display N<50 subgroups because the sample is too small to have statistical significance. We did, however, take samples of these subgroups for representational and weighting purposes to accurately reflect the electorate makeup. Some values may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
