

From July 18 to 20, 2025, Data for Progress conducted a survey with 1,199 respondent interviews of U.S. registered voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample is unweighted and represents raw responses only. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error associated with the sample size is ±3 percentage points. Results for subgroups of the sample are subject to increased margins of error. Partisanship reflected in tabulations is based on self-identified party affiliation, not partisan registration.
