

From January 30 to February 2, 2026, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,307 U.S. likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and recalled presidential vote. The survey was conducted in English.
